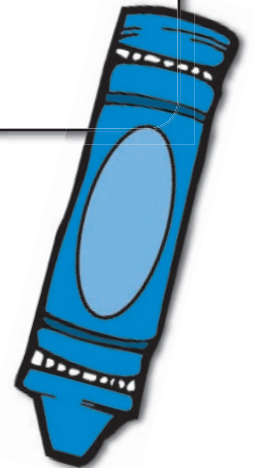
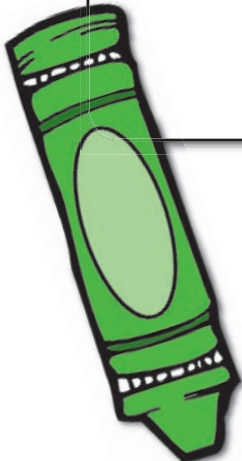
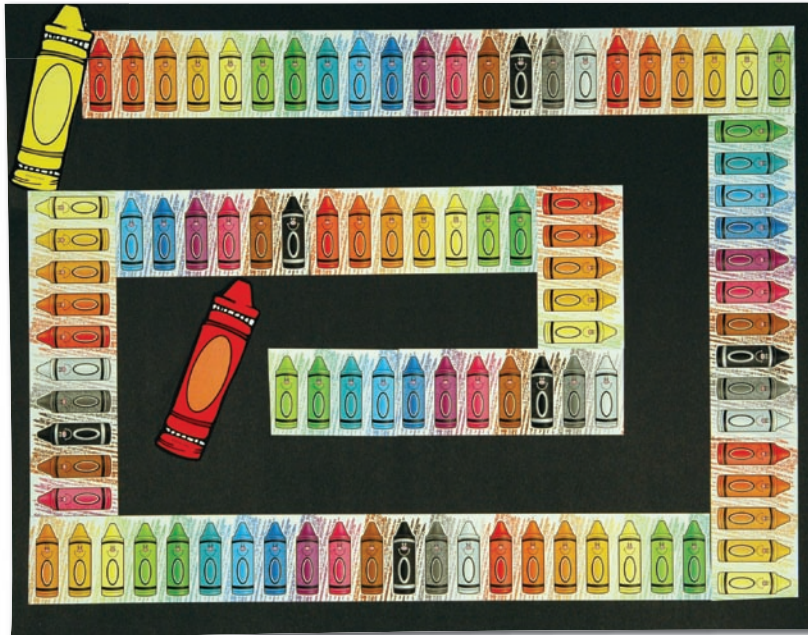
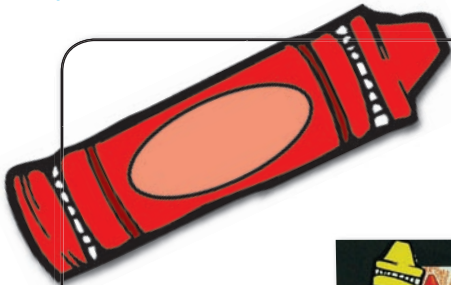


Colors Board Game



Items used to make this Project:

- CD-108016 Crayons Straight Border
- DJ-620020 Crayons Colorful Cut-Outs (Assorted Designs)
- CD-3912 Create-Your-Own Flash Cards
- Glue or tape
- Posterboard
- Labels

Directions: Glue or tape the Crayons Straight Border onto the posterboard, winding it around to create a trail game. Take one strip of Crayons Straight Border and cut apart the crayons. Take the small crayons and glue or tape them onto a half of a blank flash card. Use the Crayons Colorful Cut-Outs to label the beginning of the game "Start" and the end of the game "Finish."

How to Play: To play, place the cards face down in a pile. Each child begins with a marker on the "Start" crayon. In turn, each child will pick a crayon color flash card from the face down pile and move his or her marker to the next crayon on the board that matches the card he or she drew. The first child to the "Finish" crayon wins!
