

Five Green and Speckled Frogs



Items used to make this Project:

- DJ-620005 Froggies Colorful Cut-Outs (Single Design)
- DJ-608001 Wooden Frame Straight Border
- CD-2904 Bugs Dazzle™ Stickers
- CD-4002 Fish & Waves Pop-Apart Border
- Construction paper
- Glue or tape
- Hook-and-loop tape
- Loose leaf book rings



Directions: Place the appropriate number of frogs on each page to match the rhyme. Attach all but one—that frog will attach with hook-and-loop tape after you laminate the pages. Use the Wooden Frame Border for the log and use the water portion of the Fish & Waves Border for the water. The children/teacher can remove the frog attached to each page with hook-and-loop tape as he or she reads the line about jumping into the pool.

Rhyme:

Five green and speckled frogs
 Sat on a speckled log
 Eating the most delicious bugs
 Yum-yum!
 One jumped into the pool
 Where it was nice and cool
 Now there are four green speckled frogs.
 Glub! Glub!

Repeat rhyme and change the numbers until you have one.
