

Five Little Turkeys



Items used to make this Project:

- CD-4015 Turkeys & Checks: Kid-Drawn Pop-Apart Border
- CD-5279 Turkeys Shape Stickers
- Construction paper
- Loose leaf book rings
- Hook-and-loop dots

Directions: For the cover, place the checks side of the border along the bottom and add 5 turkey stickers. For each page, place the appropriate number of turkeys to match the verse on that page. Cut the turkeys from the turkey side of the border. You can use hook-and-loop dots to attach the last turkey on each page so that the children can remove that turkey as they read the verse.

Words for each Page:

Five little turkeys by the barn door,
One waddled off, then there were ____.

Four little turkeys out under the tree,
One waddled off, then there were ____.

Three little turkeys with nothing to do,
One waddled off, then there were ____.

Two little turkeys in the morning sun,
One waddled off, then there was ____.
