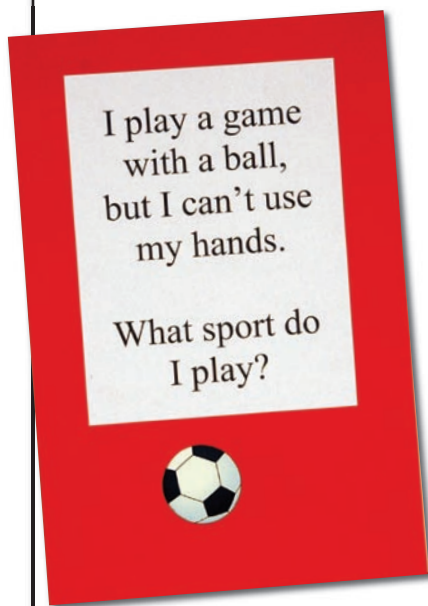


Guess What Sport I Play Book



Items used to make this Project:

- CD-110034 It's Fun to Be Fit! Bulletin Board Set
- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue or tape



Directions: Fold the construction paper in half so that it resembles a book. Punch out the athletes and their matching sports titles. Glue or tape the athlete and his or her title to the inside of the construction paper. Make a circle on the outside page of the construction paper in a place that gives a hint to which athlete is inside. Make the holes high or low on each page, so a clue can be added without covering the hole. Cut out the circles. Print a question using clues about the sport for each athlete. Glue or tape the questions to the outside of each sheet of construction paper. Use an additional piece of construction paper to wrap around the separate sheets to make a cover. Print out the title "Guess What Sport I Play?" and glue or tape it to the front cover. Open the book, read a clue and look at the hint to guess what sport the athlete plays.

Questions:

I roll on my feet and wear a helmet.
What sport do I play?
(Inline Skating)

I shout Rah Rah at the game.
What sport do I play?
(Cheerleading)

I play a game with a ball, but I can't use my hands.
What sport do I play?
(Soccer)

I use a puck and a stick to play this sport.
What sport do I play?
(Ice Hockey)

I use a racket and a small bouncy ball to play this sport.
What sport do I play?
(Tennis)

I hold my breath and go under water.
What sport do I play?
(Swimming)
