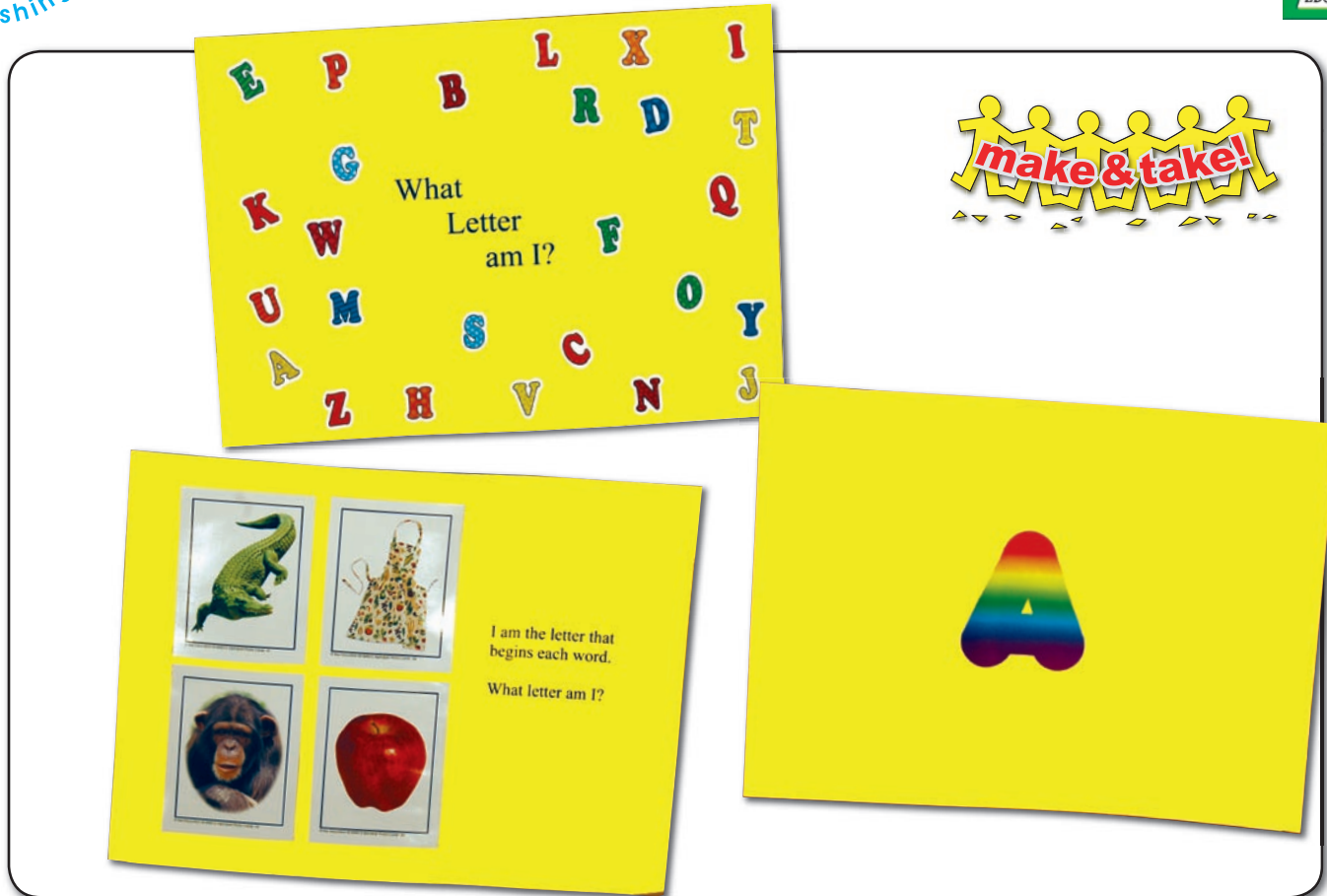


# What Letter Am I?



## Items used to make this Project:

- KE-845012 Alphabet Photo Objects Photographic Learning Cards
- CD-5241 Alphabet Shape Stickers
- CD-5349 Rainbow 3" EZ Letters
- Construction paper
- Loose leaf book rings

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**Directions:** To make the cover of the book, type, "What Letter am I?" on clear labels or computer paper and attach to the front of the page. Use one sheet of the Alphabet Shape Stickers to decorate the cover. There will be one book page for each letter of the alphabet. Sort the Alphabet Photo Objects cards by the letter they represent. On the front of the first page, paste the cards for the letter "A." Type the words, "I am the letter that begins each word. What letter am I?" on clear labels or computer paper. Place these words on the front of the page with the Alphabet Photo Objects cards. On the back of the page, paste the corresponding 3" Rainbow EZ Letter "A." Repeat the directions for each letter of the alphabet. Have students look at the pictures on the front of each page and guess what letter they represent. Turn the page to see the correct answer. This book can be used in a group, in a one-on-one assessment, or as a self-checking activity.
